Ground-Water Data for Yucca Mountain Area Presented

Data on ground-water levels, discharge, and withdrawals for calendar years 2000–02 are listed in a report recently released by the U.S. Geological Survey, Department of the Interior. Historical data are presented graphically. The report was prepared in cooperation with the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Repository Development.

Data are collected to document current (2000–02) and historical conditions of ground-water resources. These data help water-resource managers detect and document changes in those resources through time. Also, these data are used to assess ground-water resources during investigations to determine the potential suitability of Yucca Mountain for storing high-level nuclear waste.

The 133-page report, titled " Selected Ground-Water Data for Yucca Mountain Region, Southern Nevada and Eastern California, January 2000–December 2002," by Glenn L. Locke and Richard J. La Camera, is U.S. Geological Survey Open-File Report 03-387. This report are available for inspection at the U.S. Geological Survey offices in Carson City (333 W.
